PIKE	<b>BOAT:</b> Warrnambool		December - March, July - August	April - June, September - November	Daytime	Lures, blue bait	Lure trolled deep with paravene near reef
BARRACOUTA	<b>BOAT/PIER:</b> Out from Warrnambool	April, May	March	February, June	Daytime	Lures, pilchard	Trolled lure on cord or wire trace
RED FIN	<b>LAKES:</b> Lake Winslow, Lake Pertobe	February, March, December	January, April, October, November	May	Daytime	Minnows, worms, lures	Jigged lures or slowly trolled bait
TREVALLY	<b>PIER/BOAT:</b> Breakwater	August, September	July, October	January, February, November	Anytime	Prawn, worms, Cray tail	Double hook similar to whiting and sweep
ESTUARY PERCH	<b>RIVER:</b> Hopkins	January, May, June	February - April, July, November, December		Evening or during night	Shrimp, lures	Single hook float or no sinker. Fast spun lure
GUMMY SHARK	<b>SURF:</b> Logans Beach <b>BOAT:</b> Out from Warrnambool	October, November	December - March	June, July	Evening	Fish fillet	Single hook with wire trace
SCHOOL SHARK	<b>SURF/BOAT:</b> As above	June, July	May	August - October, April	Evening	Fish fillet	Single hook with wire trace

## FISHING LICENCE

All persons over the age of 18 years, fresh and sea, require a licence, even for collecting bait. Under 18, seniors, 70+ years, carers, pensioners do not require a licence.
